Item No. 58.08 : To consider the recommendations of the Chairman SUGC.

Resolution : The recommendations of the Chairman, SUGC on the request of following students of B.Tech. programme were put up before the Senate by the Chairman, SUGC for consideration on the case to case basis. The Senate resolved as below:

- (i) The Senate considered the recommendations of DUGC, Civil Engineering Department as proposed by Chairman, SUGC regarding Mr. Rohit Singh [20112070] and resolved that in order to meet the credit requirement of the programme, Mr. Rohit Singh [20112070] is allowed to undertake summer semester as a special case for course Steel Structure-I [CE1604]. The evaluation will include 20 Marks as TA component and 80 Marks for Theory examination. He is allowed to appear for this course during Supplementary Examination 2017.
- (ii) On recommendations of the Chairman, SUGC the Senate resolved that those students who have appeared in 8th semester but have E/F grade in previous semester shall be allowed to appear in total five courses in Supplementary Examination 2017 irrespective of theory or lab course.

Looking at the urgency, the Senate further resolved to approve Item No. 58.08 (i) and 58.08 (ii) for implementation and necessary action by the concerned authorities with immediate effect.

- (iii) The Senate considered the recommendations of Chairman, SUGC for changes in syllabus of some subjects of B.Tech. Mechanical Engineering and Production and Industrial Engineering of Mechanical Engineering Department and resolved to accept the same.
- (iv) As per resolution of the Senate [57.03 (ii)], the curriculum and syllabus of various departments as received were circulated among all Senate members. The syllabus of B.Tech (Mechanical Engineering) and (Production Industrial and Engineering) were also circulated among the Senate members as the revised syllabus were passed by respective DUGC & SUGC in their meeting. The Senate considered the recommendation of the Chairman, SUGC for change in syllabus of some subjects of B.Tech. (Mechanical Engineering) and (Production Industrial and Engineering) of MED, and resolved to accept the same.

The Senate also accepted the recommendation of SUGC for minor modification in syllabus of B.Tech. (Computer Science and Engineering and Information Technology), B.Tech. (Civil Engineering), B.Tech. (Electronics and Communication Engineering), B.Tech. (Electrical Engineering), subject to the condition that these minor modification are not disturbing UG Course Structure of particular programme or other U.G. programmes of the Institute.

- (v) The Senate considered the recommendation of Chairman, SUGC for changes in courses, being offered by Humanities and Social Sciences Department and resolved that there is discrepancy in the proposal and recommended changes are likely to affect existing U.G. Structure of various departments. Therefore, the Senate resolved to send recommendation to the Humanities and Social Sciences Department for detailed review and deliberation, while looking into the discrepancies in the proposal and submit fresh proposal to SUGC through DUGC for consideration of Senate after consulting concerned Engineering Departments.

Item No. 58.09 : To consider the recommendations of the Chairman SMPC.

Resolution : The recommendations of the Chairman, SMPC on the request of following students of Masters' programme were put up before the Senate by the Chairman, SMPC for consideration on the case to case basis. The Senate

resolved as below:

- (i) The Senate considered the course structure and syllabus of the M.Tech. programme of different departments/ School/ Cell of the Institute. The revised course structure of Master's Programmes of Computer Science and Engineering Department, Electrical Engineering Department, Electronics and Communication Engineering Department, GIS Cell, Humanities and Social Sciences, Mechanical Engineering Department and School of Management Studies were circulated among the members of the Senate and no comments were received. The Senate resolved to accept the course structure and syllabus of these department/School/Cell as per recommendation by DMPC and SMPC. The course structure and syllabus of Mathematics department was changed after recommendation of SMPC and therefore it was referred back to the department to route it through SMPC for consideration of the Senate.
- (ii) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding the medical leave of Mr. Ravi Prakash Singh (2016BM14), Biomedical Engineering, who was injured in an accident on 27.03.2017. The Senate resolved to grant admissible leave with stipend and remaining without stipend.
- The case of medical leave of Mr. Aman Khurana (2015AM01) was also discussed. Mr. Khurana was suffering from retinal detachment and doctor had advised him bed rest. He had requested to grant medical leave from 10.04.2017 to 26.04.2017. The Senate resolved to grant him admissible leave with stipend and remaining without stipend.
- (iii) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding the termination of Mr. Trandeep Singh Rana [2016PR13] as Mr. Rana secured CPI Less than 5.5 in two consecutive Semesters. The Senate resolved to terminate him.
- (iv) The Senate considered the case of Mr. Sunny Yadav [2015TR08] who was selected in NPCC Ltd. and was granted semester leave of Odd Semester 2016-17. He is still under probation and therefore requested again to grant semester leave for Even Semester of session 2016-17. On the recommendation of DMPC and SMPC the Senate resolved to

allow Mr. Sunny Yadav [2015TR08] semester leave for Even Semester of Session 2016-17.

Item No. 58.14 : Any other matter with permission of the Chair.



A. For INSPIRE Faculty

1. INSPIRE Faculty awardee will apply for host Institute with award certificate to the Director. The Director will forward the awardee application to Dean [FW] for further processing & recommendation of the DFAC of the concerned Department for assessing the suitability of the applicant.
2. The Institute will issue offer letter to the awardee on the receipt of specific recommendation of DFAC and Dean [FW].
3. INSPIRE Faculty Awardee will directly join the Department concerned and submit the joining to the Director through concern Head of the Department/Centres/Cell & Dean [R&C].
4. The candidate will abide by the rules of the Institute & other terms & conditions of INSPIRE Faculty Award.


B. For National Post Doctoral Fellowship [NPDF]/Post Doctoral Fellow[PDF]

1. The applicant must identify a suitable Mentor/Supervisor under whom the proposed research would be carried out.
2. The application form along with a research proposal highlighting the objectives of the research work to be undertaken should be submitted to the Director with consent of the Mentor/Supervisor and specific recommendations of the concerned DFAC of the Department/Centres/Cell through Dean (R&C).
3. After the Award of NPDF/PDF, the candidate will directly join the Department concerned and submit the joining to the Director through concern Head of the Department/Centres/Cell & Dean [R&C].
4. The candidate will abide by the rules of the Institute & other terms & conditions of funding agency.




Duties, responsibility of post doctoral fellow(PDF)/National post doctoral fellow (NPDF)/INSPIRE Faculty

1. In addition to research, the Head of the Department/Centres/Cell may assign reasonable academic/administrative tasks depending on the need for PDF/NPDF.
2. The PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE awardee will be required to contribute significantly in the practical courses by the Department/Centres/Cell.
3. The PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE awardee is expected to help in upkeep of lab infrastructure and various facilities of the Department/Centres/Cell.
4. For INSPIRE Faculty, the Head of the Department may assign academic/administrative tasks equivalent the Assistant Professor level depending on the need.
5. The Department/Centres/Cell may try to provide reasonable office and lab space to the PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE Faculty.
6. In addition, the Department/Centres/Cell may engage PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE Faculty as co-guide for B.Tech./M.Tech. projects with permanent faculty as main supervisor.
7. INSPIRE Faculty may also act as co-supervisor only for the Ph.D. thesis of the project staff appointed in INSPIRE scheme [Course Code: 14] with permanent faculty as main supervisor.
8. For all matters, the INSPIRE awardee will report directly to the Head of the concerned Department/Centres/Cell or his nominee.
9. The implementation of the PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE shall be done through Dean [R&C] of MNNIT Allahabad and shall be governed by its norms including purchase procedures.
10. The PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE awardee will be required to have personal insurance for the duration of his/her work for working in laboratories.
11. The PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE awardee will be allowed to avail only OPD facilities for self, spouse and dependent children.
12. The PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE awardee will be eligible for housing in the campus subject to availability.
13. The PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE awardee will be issued temporary ID card for the tenure of award.
14. The other terms and conditions of the service of PDF/NPDF/INSPIRE Faculty shall be such as may be specified by the appointing authority.
15. At the end/termination of their tenure, the awardee has to take proper No dues and submit their ID card.


