The Finance Committee considered the recommendations of the Thirty-fourth [34th] meeting of the Building & Works Committee [B&WC] held on 15.02.2021 on the proposal of following proposed modifications/additional items in the ongoing work of Construction of Girls Hostel (G+6) at Institute as per requirement of GRIHA for obtaining 3 Star Rating:

SI. No.	Proposed modifications/additional items						
1.	Provision of Toughened glass with SHGC (Solar Heat Gain Coefficient) /Solar Factor of 0.45 (max.) and VLT >40% in all windows of the building instead of normal 6 mm glass						
2.	Drip irrigation system for 100% of landscape area

3.	Provision of low flow fixtures and systems to control the flow of water and wastage.
4.	Provision of Roof Envelope blocks 310 mm x 240 mm x 50 mm on terra
5.	Provision of 6 Nos. rain water harvesting chambers with percolation pipe of 200mm dia.
6.	Provision of LED lights in place of CFL lights.
7.	Provision of BEE 3 star rated fans in place of normal fans.
8.	Provision of separate overhead tanks for flushing lines to use the treated water obtained from STP.

The Finance Committee was apprised that the above items are mandatory for obtaining 3-star rating from GRIHA and also the above-mentioned additional works will be executed within the tendered cost.

Considering above, the Finance Committee resolved to recommend the same to the Board of Governors for approval.
