Guidelines for executing bond in case of an employee going on extraordinary leave

- All staff members (both academic and non academic) who are sponsored/deputed by the institute for higher training /study abroad under collaborative arrangement and / or Government of India scholarship schemes etc. should execute service bond for the period as specified below:
 - (i) If the secondment is for a period of more than 3 months.

2 years

(ii) If the secondment period is less than 3 months.

No bond

- 2. All bonds will be signed by the staff member concerned with the sureties from two persons acceptable to the Institute for the purpose.
- 3. An employee will be eligible to avail a maximum of 5 years of extra ordinary leave, without pay and allowance, during the entire period of the service.
- 4. An employee will be eligible for extra ordinary leave at the rate of one year for every 5 years of service put in at this institute except for higher studies leading to the award of a degree.
- On any single occasion, an employee can avail extra ordinary leave for a maximum of 2 years. Also, there must be a minimum interval of 3 years between 2 consecutive Extra Ordinary Leave when duration of which exceeds 6 months.
- 6. Not more than 15% of the Faculty, actually working in any Department, shall be allowed to be out of the Department at any scheme, including visiting appointments abroad, for periods of over 6 months in each case. No such restriction shall apply to cases where the period of deputation/leave is upto 6 months.
- 7. The condition regarding grant of leave after the lapse of three years from the date of the return from the previous leave shall apply only in the cases of leave granted for the periods of over 6 months.
- 8. The slots occupied by Faculty members on deputation against the 15% quota would stand vacated after the expiry of two years or the deputation period even if the faculty member has not returned to the Institute.
- If any staff member avails extra ordinary leave due to him without any financial assistance, he/she will not have to execute the bond.
- 10. If any staff members goes on any leave for a certain duration with financial assistance and due to any un -avoidable circumstances, he/she has to avail extra ordinary leave in continuation, he/she will have to executive a bond of Rs. 5 lacs.
- 11. Those staff members who avail extra ordinary leave for more than 2 years shall have to execute a bond to serve the institute, for same number of years as availed by them as extra ordinary leave, after returning to the institute after availing extra ordinary leave.
 - In the event of failure to comply with the above, he/she shall have to refund the entire salary given to him/her by the institute during such leave with interest thereon.
- 12. Form 6, 7, or 8 (as may be applicable) specified in the CCS rules shall be used for executing the bond.
