We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology (Institute), Allahabad as at 31 March 2014, the Income and Expenditure Account and Receipt and Payment Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with section 22(2) of the National Institutes of Technology Act, 2007. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Institute's Management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

- 2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (C&AG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observation on financial transactions with regard to compilance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any are, reported through Inspection Reports/C&AG's Audit Reports separately.
- 3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining on a test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

Based on our audit, we report that:

(i) We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;

- The Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure Account and Receipts and Payment Account dealt with by this report have not been drawn in Uniform format of accounts prescribed by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India.
- In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have (iii) been maintained in the Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology, Allahabad in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- (iv) We further report that:
- **Balance Sheet** (A)

Fixed Assets -Tangible Assets \$158.27 crore

Depreciation on vehicles was charged at the rate of 13.91 per cem instead of 25.89per cent as per provisions of company Act 1956, which has been adopted by the Institute. This has resulted in understatement of depreciation by ₹ 2.22 lakh and overstatement of vehicles by same amount.

General **(B)**

Format of Accounts

Ministry of Finance, GOI had introduced Uniform Format of Accounts for all Central Autonomous Bodies in 2001 in consultation with CAG of India. Balance Sheet of the Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology, Allahabad has been prepared in the new format of account introduced by Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India for institutions of higher education, which is still under finalization in consultation with CAG of India.

Grants-in-aid (C)

During the year 2013-14, the Institute received grant of ₹ 63.25 crore from Government of India (Plan ₹ 24.25 crore, Non-plan ₹ 39.00 crore). The Institute had an opening balance of ₹ 31.02crore (Plan ₹ 9.55crore, Non-Plan ₹ 21.47 crore)and generated its own income of ₹ 16.29 crore. Thus, total funds available works out to ₹ 110.56crore, out of which the Institute utilised ₹ 116.76 crore (Plan ₹ 54.24 crore, Non-Plan ₹ 62.52 crore) leaving a balance of ₹ (-) 6.20crore (Plan ₹ (-) 20.44crore, Non-Plan ₹ 14.24 crore) as on 31 March 2014.

v. Subject to our observation in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure Account and Receipt and Payment Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in annexure give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India.
