The Chairperson extended a warm welcome to the members and thanked them for taking their time out to attend the meeting. At the very onset the Chairperson observed that the stipulated time periods of 15 days for notification of the BoG/FC meeting and 10 days for circulation of detailed agenda items have not been complied by the Secretary/Member Secretary of the BoG/FC. He emphasized that the prescribed deadlines be strictly adhered to in future. It was also mentioned that it is a settled position that all agenda items which are placed before the Finance Committee and the Board of Governors are placed only after recommendations of institution. However, it has been observed that specific recommendations have not been put up with each agenda items requiring recommendations of FC or approval of BoG. Henceforth, recommendations of the Institutions should accompany each agenda item.

Item No. 41.01 : To confirm the minutes of the Fortieth [40th] meeting of the Board of Governors held on 23.09.2015.

Resolution

: Director (NITs), Ministry of HRD sent his comments which were incorporated after discussion in the meeting. The Board of Governors confirmed the minutes of its Fortieth [40th] meeting held on 23.09.2015 at NIT Transit House, A-1/267, Safdarjung Enclave, New Delhi, as circulated.

The Board of Governors noted the following observations of the members and resolved to place the same on records.

- (i) Prof. S. K. Duggal. The points suggested by Prof. S.K. Duggal are placed as ANNEXURE-I. The BoG stressed that all concerned should make best efforts to address the issues raised by Prof. Duggal.
- (ii) The replies given to the observations of Prof. A.K. Chaturvedi and Dr. Audhesh Narayan by the Registrar are placed as ANNEXURE-II. The Chairman directed the Registrar that minutes of the meeting be noted properly so as to minimize the errors at the time of preparing the final draft.

Item No. 41.03

: Director's Report.

Resolution

The Director presented the report on the various activities of the Institute after the 40th meeting of the BoG. The BoG noted the following.

- (i) There is some deviations in the data compiled in the Agenda document and that presented by the Director. The Director clarified that the report presents the information as on date while the agenda document is based on data available at the time of preparation of the same. In view of the above, the Director proposed that the report of the Director be incorporated in the agenda details of the subsequent meeting. The BoG approved the proposal for future records.
- (ii) In addition to the presentation by the Director, there is a need for the detailed presentation by individual Departments regarding change in curriculum, research activities, research papers/publications, patents etc. or any such activities that the Department may deem fit, on turn by turn basis. The BoG resolved that the new practice shall start right from the next BOG with the Department of Applied

Mechanics followed by the other Departments in alphabetical order.

- (iii) The Chairman commended the faculty and staff of MNNIT for academic achievement of the institute as reflected in the recently concluded NIT Council meeting at NIT, Warangal. He also expressed satisfaction that MNNIT Allahabad has fulfilled most of the requirements and further emphasized that MNNIT Allahabad has tremendous potential to perform even better.
- (iv) The Chairman, Board of Governors also noted the participation of students of MNNIT Allahabad in various games and sports events and commended their excellent achievements in the same.
- (v) The Chairman pointed out that the placement data should include total number of students and also reflect the total number of students eligible for placement.

Item No. 41.07

: To consider the representation/request of Non-teaching Association of the Institute regarding constitution of a Special DPC.

Resolution

- The Board of Governors considered the issue pertaining to promotion of the Non-faculty staff. The Committee made following observation/recommendation:-
 - (i) The Non-teaching employees of the Institute have not got any promotion since 2002. Therefore, DPC must be constituted department-wise immediately as per rules.
 - (ii) The DPC should follow the existing Recruitment Rules for promotion.
- (iii) The date of promotion of Non-teaching staff shall be taken as the date on which the recommendation of the DPC is approved by the Competent Authority.
- (Iv) The cases of existing non-teaching employee who are otherwise eligible for promotion except for the requisite qualifications shall be taken up urgently with the Ministry of HRD for granting them one time relaxation as regards their education qualification.

Item No. 41.08

To consider the request made by the President, Teachers' Association, MNNIT Allahabad for considering the demands of Teachers' Association.

Resolution

The Board of Governors noted that an SLP has been filed by Ministry of HRD and NIT Allahabad in Hon'ble Supreme Court against the decision of Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad in the recruitment of faculty under 4-Tier. As a result, the Institute is unable to recruit new regular faculty members and promote the existing faculty members who are otherwise eligible. This has resulted into an acute shortage of faculty members and resentment amongst them. Therefore, the Board resolved that a special representation to the Chairperson NiT Council be made to explore the possibility of initiating the recruitment under the previous recruitment rules pending the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The members felt that the same is in line with the decision of the Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad (page number 19 of the judgment) reproduced below.

"Thus this much is clear that whatever has been the terms and conditions in existence on the date of enforcement of the Act, same was to continue unless it was not duly eltered by the Statutes."

The Board of Governors also advised the Institute Administration to make a strong recommendation in support of the above highlighting the following facts:-

- (i) There is an acute shortage of faculty members across the Departments.
- (ii) An unacceptable high students to faculty ratio which is affecting the teaching-learning process
- (iii) Increasing discontentment among faculty members.
- (iv) An increased attrition in the recent past due to lack of career advancement opportunity in MNNIT, Allahabad.
- (v) Academic standards jeopardized in view of Serial No. (i) to (iv).
- (vi) The reputation of the Institute is at stake and is likely to affect the ranking of the Institute adversely.

It was also opined that the Chairman BoG and the Director MNNIT must seek appointment with the Hon'ble HRM and apprise her about the situation.

The Chairman expressed his disappointment over the way the BoG meetings are convened. He pointed out that a large number of agenda items remain unattended because of lack of preparedness during the preparation of the detailed agenda items. In his concluding remarks the Chairman stated that agenda of FC and BoG meeting should invariably be accompanied by formal recommendations of the Institute administration. The Director (NITs) supported his views commenting that the practice of giving formal recommendation on agenda points by the Institute administration is mandatory and is prevalent in other NITs. After deliberation the BoG resolved to advise the Institute administration to make its recommendations an integral part of the Agenda items for future meetings.

The meeting ended with thanks to the Chair.

Response to Dr Audesh Narayan's Observations.docx

Response to the Observations of Dr Audesh Narayan, Bog Members

 Agenda items should be circulated well in time so that the BoG members can read the complete agenda comfortably.

Response: All efforts have been made to circulate agenda items in time but due to inclusion of agenda items at the last moment and considering voluminous documents & rules to be referred for preparation of agenda papers it gets slightly delayed. But at the same time members should also appreciate the time required in the preparation of minutes and in the present case the agenda was circulated by mail as well as in hard copy at least five days before the date of the meeting.

Any report/recommendations consisting of thick bunch of papers must be circulated to BoG members well before the scheduled date of the meeting so that reports/recommendations can be critically examined.

Response: The same has already been taken care off and are recorded in the minutes of the 40th Meeling of the BoG. Sometimes it may happen that due to confidentiality of the subject the sealed cover of the report is opened and the same is read and circulated among all the BoG members. Notwithstanding, as per decision of the Board, agenda will be accordingly prepared in future.

- Minutes of some of the agenda items (Item No. 40.07, 40.08, 40.14) are not prepared in accordance with resolution in the meeting
- 4. In reference to Item No. 40.07, minutes of committee consisting of thick bunch of papers was circulated during the meeting. Therefore, it is not possible to critically examine the reports of committees in such a short period of time. After reviewing the recommendations of the committees, I have the following observations:
 - i. In reference to MHRD Letter Nos. F. No. 23-1/2008-TS.II; dated 18th August,2009 and F. No. 38-17/2011-TS-III, dated March, 2013, it is observed that additional Increments given to junior faculty members were wrong and it was against the above MHRD order. Additional increments should have NOT been given to junior faculty members. Due to wrong fixation of junior faculty members, anomalies have been created.
 - II. Addition increments given to junior faculty members due to acquiring of higher qualification. Here, higher qualification seems to be misinterpreted in the rule FR (22) GIO (23) para 2. Here, higher qualification is a relative term so it should be interpreted relatively. Qualification acquired by junior faculty members is NOT higher than the senior faculty members because that qualification was already earned by the senior faculty members since long back. Therefore, the pay of a junior faculty should not be higher than a senior faculty. Therefore, decision of the BoG in its 24th meeting for stepping of salaries of senior faculty members was correct.

Response: Minutes only relate the decision taken in the meeting on the basis of discussion taken place in the meeting. In the instant case, the recommendations of the Committee were read before the Board of Governors and the BoG unanimously resolved to accept the recommendations of the Committee. The Board also noted that the recommendations of this Committee as well as the recommendations of the earlier Committee with Prof. G R C Reddy Director, NIT Goa, as the Chairman of the Committee and both are on the same lines.

5. In reference to Item No. 40.08, regarding the case of Dr.Ajaya Bharti for release of increments after regularization of his services, nothing was discussed in earlier board meeting (39th BoG) but the minute says it was discussed while the matter of Dr. Bharti was deferred for the next meeting. The case of Dr. Bharti was discussed in 40th Board meeting and it was resolved that increments for extended period for PhD completion will not be given but excluding extended period, increments may be released. However, the same is not clear from the minute.

Response: In the minutes in respect of Item No. 40.08, the earlier Board referred not the 39th meeting of BoG but the decisions taken in the earlier meetings (i.e., 33rd and 26th). Resolutions of these meetings are available in the agenda papers. From the agenda note it is very clear that the matter was deferred in its 39th meeting. The resolution of the 26th meeting [item NO. 26.09] has a clear mention of the fact that no increments will be given for the extended period. On completion of Ph.D. Dr.Ajay Bhartl shall be granted annual increment in July 2015 during action taken of this BoG report.

Thus the recording of resolution is correct.

In reference to agenda Item No. 40.14, regarding the irregularities in consultancy work of Kumbh Mela-2013, the role of the institute CVO was questioned but it is not included in the minute.

Response: In the meeting, remarks of the institute CVO on the recommendations of the Two Member Committee was read before the Board and on the basis of the same it was resolved to constitute a Three Member External Committee.

Thus the recording of resolution is correct.
