

The Board of Governors confirmed the minutes of its 22nd meeting held on 27.01.2010 at 11:30 A.M. in the Conference Room, MNNIT Allahabad with following modification:

"The Board of Governors desired that it would be better if the CAS interviews are within twelve months from the previous selection process"


23.03 Director's Report:

23.07: To consider the communication received from MHRD regarding approval of mapping of pay scales of Non-teaching employees as communicated by the MHRD vide letter No.F.2-8/2009-TS.III dated 12th March 2010.

The Board of Governors was apprised about the communication received from MHRD regarding approval of mapping of pay scales of non-teaching employees as communicated by the MHRD vide letter No. F.2-8/2009- TS.III, dated 12th March, 2010 and the Institute's observations on the same regarding some discrepancies in above mapping of pay scales communicated to MHRD vide letter No. 50(A)/AOS-53/2010 dated 05.05.2010. The Board of Governors resolved to wait for the MHRD's response for the Institute letter before any further action.

23.08: To consider the restructuring of Non-teaching staff of the Institute as communicated by MHRD vide letter No. F.23-18/2008-TS.III dated 17.03.2010

The Board of Governors considered the Institute proposal for restructuring of non-teaching staff in the Institute in accordance to the MHRD letter No.F.23-18/2008- TS-III dated 17.03.2010, and approved the same. A copy of proposal for restructuring of non-teaching staff in the Institute as

approved by the Board of Governors is enclosed here as **Annexure – A**, which is being submitted to the MHRD for sanction of additional posts.

23.09:

To consider the representation of the Teacher's Association for consideration of the date of eligibility/promotion for grant of higher AGP.

The Board of Governors considered the representation of the teachers Association for consideration of the date of eligibility /promotion for grant of higher AGP, in accordance with the para 2 of the MHRD letter No. F.20-48/2003-TS.III, dated June 4, 2004 and resolved that the matter may be referred to the MHRD for clarification stating that Institute agrees with the points mentioned in representation of the Teachers Association but the same could not be implemented in the Institute because of the MHRD letter of even No. dated April 6, 2004 according to which *"Initial pay fixation and consequent of financial benefits in the promotion grade shall be only from the date of the meeting of BOG in which recommendations are approved and there would not be any notional benefits/pay fixation prior to this date April 6, 2004"*.

The Board of Governors further resolved that as the column No. 7 (Date of designation) as mentioned in the Institute office order No. 1073/Estt-1; 1074/Estt-1 dated 15.12.2009 notifying the date of eligibility for next promotion, etc to the faculty members promoted under CAS; is creating confusion amongst the faculty member leading to such representations, therefore the column which is being used for long time in the Institute, may be modified suitably or if not needed, may be removed from these office orders.

23.10:

To consider recruitment of faculty on implementation of Sixth Central Pay Commission.

The Board of Governors considered the Institute proposal for the recruitment of faculty on implementation of Sixth Central Pay Commission and resolved that as, as of now, no communication has been received about the norms for recruitment of faculty as per Sixth CPC and the committee constituted by the MHRD for framing up of recruitment rules for faculty positions in NITs has also not submitted its recommendations till date. Other NITs, IIITs are also



recruiting , therefore, the Institute is left with no other alternative, but to go for recruitment of faculty positions with the previous eligibility norms mapped to new positions such as –
