24.08: To consider the request made by teaching staff for:

(a) For consideration for AGP of ₹12000/- to the Professors who have completed six years of service as Professor.

The Board of Governors considered the request made by some professors for consideration of AGP of ₹12000/- to professors, who have completed six years of service as Professor and resolved that a Committee may be constituted by the Director for suggesting the criterion and procedure to be adopted for placing of such professors in the higher Academic Grade Pay of ₹12000/-. The Committee will also act as Screening Committee for evaluation of biodata of eligible professors for the consideration of higher Academic Grade Pay of ₹12000/-. The Board of Governors further resolved that the grant of higher Academic Grade Pay to such professors will be subject to submission of an undertaking by them to the effect that any guidelines/norms received from MHRD/Anomaly Committee constituted by MHRD will have an overriding effect on the recommendations of the Committee, and would be modified accordingly.

(b) Stepping up of pay of seniors at par to that of juniors, which has been fixed as MHRD notification.

The Board of Governors considered the request made by some members of faculty for stepping up of pay of seniors at par to that of juniors, which has been fixed as per MHRD notification and resolved that pay of seniors, who are drawing less pay as compared to their juniors on account of grant of increments for acquiring higher qualifications on or after 01.01.2006, may be stepped up at par to that of the juniors. Any such stepping up will be considered only on receipt of specific request from faculty members clearly indicating the name, date and other details of juniors, who are drawing higher pay on implementation of Sixth CPC. However, this stepping up of pay will be subject to submission of an undertaking by such faculty member to the effect that any guidelines/norms received from MHRD/Anomaly Committee constituted by MHRD will have an overriding effect on the stepping up of the pay, and would be modified accordingly.
