Agenda item-wise proceedings are as follows :

**Item No. 47.01** : **To confirm the minutes of the Forty Sixth (46<sup>th</sup>) meeting of the Senate held on 18.11.2013 and Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Emergent meeting held on 11.02.2014.**

**Resolution** : The Senate confirmed the minutes of its Forty Sixth (46<sup>th</sup>) meeting held on 18.11.2013 and its Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Emergent meeting held on 11.02.2014, as circulated.

**Item No. 47.02** : **To consider the action taken on the decisions taken in the Forty Sixth (46<sup>th</sup>) meeting of the Senate held on 18.11.2013 and Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Emergent meeting held on 11.02.2014.**

**Resolution** : The Senate noted the action taken on the decisions taken its Forty Sixth (46<sup>th</sup>) meeting held on 18.11.2013 and its tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Emergent meeting held on 11.02.2014, as circulated.



**Item No. 47.03 : To consider the eligibility criteria for B.Tech. students to be admitted under ICCR Scholarship scheme.**

**Resolution :** The Senate considered the proposal regarding eligibility criteria for B.Tech. Students to be admitted under ICCR Scholarship Scheme and noted that the Institute admits students under this scheme as per Ministry of HRD guidelines. In view of above the Senate resolved that Ministry of HRD may be requested to communicate the eligibility criteria for admission of students to B.Tech. programme under the ICCR scholarship scheme in the Institute.

**Item No. 47.04 : To consider the proposal from Director, NIT Uttarakhand for grant of privileges to non-Ph.D. faculty of NIT Uttarakhand.**

**Resolution :** The Senate considered the proposal from the Director, NIT Uttarakhand for grant of privileges to non-Ph.D. faculty of NIT Uttarakhand. The Senate observed that as per Ordinances for Doctoral Programme of the Institute, the minimum residency period in the Ph.D. programme is two years. Therefore, the Institute may admit non-Ph.D. faculty of NIT Uttarakhand in the Ph.D. programme of the Institute subject to the condition that such admitted candidates shall be required to complete the requirement of minimum residency period. The Senate therefore, resolved that such candidates shall only be admitted if the necessary study leave is granted by the parent Institution. Also resolved that the above information be communicated to the Director, NIT Uttarakhand.

**Item No. 47.05 : To consider the mercy applications of students.**

**Resolution :** The decisions of the Senate on the mercy appeals of the students are as under.

- (i) The Senate considered the mercy appeal of Mr. Indrasen Singh [2010RE151], a Ph.D. student of Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, whose programme was terminated by the Senate in its 45<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 10.10.2013 and resolved to turn down his mercy appeal as no new facts have been mentioned in his mercy appeal.
- (ii) The Senate considered the recommendations of the DMPC of the School of Management Studies on the mercy appeal of Mr. Bipin Kumar Rawat [2012 MB79], to allow him to appear in the Supplementary Examination in July 2014 and comments of Chairman, SMPC thereon. The Senate resolved

that the matter may be put up before the Senate in its next meeting with full details of facts and figures for further consideration.

- (iii) The Senate considered the recommendations of DMPC of the Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering on the mercy appeal of Mr. Shambhu Sharan Singh [2012EL03], a student of M.Tech. (Digital Systems) for semester leave for the even semester of 2013-14, in continuation to the semester leave in the odd semester of 2013-14, and resolved to allow him for semester leave for the even semester of 2013-14 subject to the condition that he shall not be allowed for any further leave. Also resolved that the same may be communicated to the student concerned by the concerned Head of the Department.
- (iv) The Senate considered the recommendations of the DMPC on the request of Mr. Abhishek Kumar Singh [2012CM18], a student of M.Tech. (Communication Systems) who has completed three semesters of M.Tech. programme, for grant of one semester leave and resolved to grant him the same.
- (v) The Senate considered the recommendations of the DMPC of the School of Management Studies on the request of Mr. Varun Kumar [2013MB16] for grant of leave for one more semester in continuation to the semester leave allowed in the odd semester of 2013-14 and resolved that the matter may be put up before the Senate in its next meeting with full details of facts and figures for consideration.

**Item No. 47.06 :** To consider the request received from IETE for recognition of course offered by the Institute for admission to different programmes of institute.

**Resolution :** The Senate considered the request received from the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers [IETE] for recognition of its Advanced Level Course in Computer Science [ALCCS] as equivalent to M.Tech. [Computer Science] for admission to Ph.D. programme; Graduateship [AMIETE] Examination as equivalent to B.E./B.Tech. programme for admission to M.Tech. programme and Diploma level [DiplIETET and DiplIETE-CS] Examination as equivalent to Diploma in Electronics & Communication and Diploma in Computer Science Engineering

respectively for admission in B.Tech. course for lateral entry in the Institute. The decision of the Senate is as under.

- (i) In order to establish the equivalence of ALCCS [Computer Science] with M.Tech. (Computer Science), IETE may be requested to provide detailed syllabus, scheme of examination and other relevant details for consideration by the Institute.
- (ii) The Graduateship [AMIETE] Examination of the IETE is already recognized by the Institute and the same is considered equivalent to B.Tech. for pursuing higher studies in the Institute i.e. M.Tech. The same may be communicated to IETE.
- (iii) The Senate observed that there is no provision for admission through lateral entry in the B.Tech. programmes in the Institute. The Senate, therefore, resolved that the recognition of the DipIETE-ET and DipIETE-CS does not arise and this request of IETE may not be acceded to.

**Item No. 47.07 : To consider the application of Mr. Paramhans Singh [Reg. No. 2013ST22] for sanction of one year leave.**

**Resolution :** The Senate considered the request of Mr. Paramhans Singh [2013ST22], a M.Tech. [Structural Engineering] student, for grant of leave for one year and resolved that the same may not be acceded to as no provisions for the same exists in the Ordinances for Masters' programme of the Institute.

- (i) The Senate considered the recommendations of the DUGC of the Department of Electronics and Communications Engineering on the request of Mr. Tejaswi Talabathula [20095122], B.Tech. Fourth year [ECED], to allow him to appear in five subjects in the Supplementary Examination and resolved to turn down his request, as the final year students have already been granted permission to appear in maximum four subjects.
- (ii) The Senate considered the request made by Mr. Nirmal Sarawagi [20113109], B.Tech. II year, Mechanical Engineering to allow him to register in VII semester as per provisions of the old Ordinances, and resolved to allow him for the same.
- (iii) The Senate considered the recommendations of the SUGC on the request of Ms. Aradhana Kumari [20135130], B.Tech. 1<sup>st</sup> year, Electronics and Communication Engineering and Mr. Manish Kumar [20126019], B.Tech. 
grounds and resolved to allow them for the same.
